

TRIANGLE TAKEOVER™

A TRIANGLE HAS THREE POINTS. THIS GAME HAS A FEW MORE. LET'S GET INTO IT.

Basically, this game is about creating and claiming triangles. You can create triangles by strategically placing rubber bands from one point to another.

The goal? Claim the most triangles!

SETUP

Place the game board in the center. Everyone picks a color peg. Then, divide up the rubber bands so everyone has the same amount to play with.

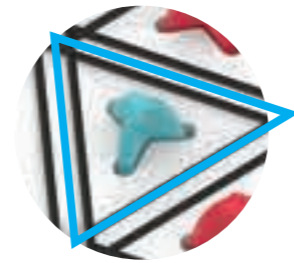
The youngest player goes first. What do they do? So glad you asked.

HOW TO PLAY

On your turn, you can place one rubber band anywhere on the board. You must stretch it between 4 posts and it must be in a straight line.

If a player closes a triangle with their rubber band, they claim it. Place your peg in the triangle to make it official.

Nice job.



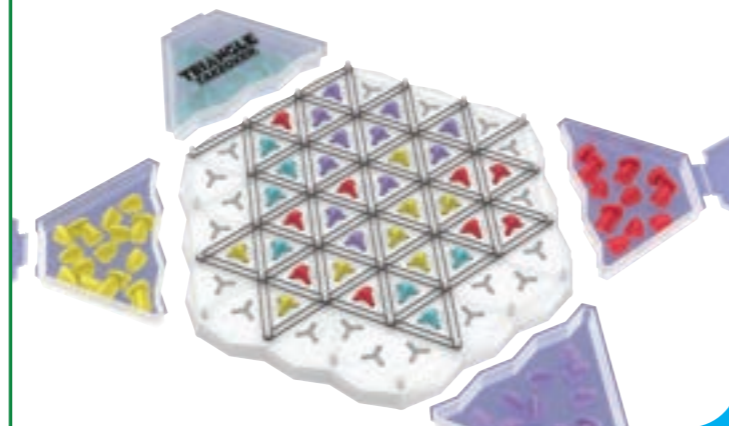
Heads up—triangles can share sides with other triangles.



Once a turn is over, play continues to the left. The next player will place their rubber band across the pegs they want.

Play until all triangles are claimed or until one player uses all of their pegs.
